#### **Organizational Matters**

- 1. **THE SPRING HUNTSVILLE PRESBYTERY WAS CONSTITUTED** with thirty-six (36) ministers, and eighteen (18) churches. Four (4) licentiates also answered the roll.
- 2. **RECEIVED** excellent hospitality from the host, Mt Zion CPCA.
- 3. **RECEIVED** greetings from the Moderator, The Reverend Terence Haley.

- 13. **HEARD** a verbal report from the Board of Budget and Finance.

14. **ADOPTED** the Ad Hoc Committee to New Heaven Report which recommended that the Huntsville Presbytery as well as retaining its charter, which is to help bring about reconciliation and renewal within the New Heaven CPCA church family; and pray fully to avoid another painful breakup within a constituted church within our Presbytery.
